Menstrual bleeding may be heavier or lighter, earlier or later after taking **Next Choice<sup>®</sup>**. If your period is more than a week late, pregnancy should be considered. Do not take **Next Choice<sup>®</sup>** if you have undiagnosed vaginal bleeding or are allergic to levonorgestrel or any of the ingredients in **Next Choice<sup>®</sup>**. **Next Choice<sup>®</sup>** should not be used for routine birth control.
